What does naturally-grown, Certified Organic, chemical-free, CSA, etc., mean?

Certified Organic farms are approved by the U.S. Department of Agriculture to be free of synthetic chemicals, antibiotics, and hormones in crop and livestock production. Certified Naturally Grown farms have been approved to meet the USDA National Organic Program standards through a non-profit farmer-to-farmer certification program, which is specially tailored for small-scale farmers who are striving to strengthen the organic movement by preserving organic values and selling locally and directly. Naturally-grown or organically-grown means that the farm is growing food in accordance with organic principles, but is not independently certified. All-natural or chemical-free means that the farm uses no synthetic chemical inputs on its produce or livestock. Pasture-raised and, generally, cage-free and grass-fed animals are raised in a more humane manner on a pasture, as opposed to being kept in confinement and fed primarily grains. A CSA, or Community Supported Agriculture, consists of a partnership between a farm and the local food-buying community, with the community supporting the farm and farmer and in return receiving fresh, local produce.
